Day 1

Arrive at Coimbatore airport /railway station . Our representative meets and welcomes you on your arrival. About Ooty

Ooty is the "Queen of Hill stations" nestled in the Nilgiri range and popularly known as Ooty, A Britisher Mr. John Sullivan discovered Ooty in 1821; the sheer grandeur of this romantic city is enough to drain anyone out.



Day 4

After Breakfast at 7:30am drop at Ooty Railway station to Coonoor by toy train. On arrival Coonoor Railway Station pickup and proceed to explore Coonoor Rail Tourism. Enjoy the journey on the World Heritage Nilgiri Mountain Railway from Ooty to Coonoor. (19 Kms of journey : 04 intermittent stations, 03 tunnels and a long bridge). Coonoor stands on a lower ridge of the plateau at an altitude of 1,858 mts. and has a railway station on the Mettupalayam - Udhagamandalam route. Around and near Coonoor, the tourists can enjoy the beautiful places of interest like Sim's Park. Lamb's rock. Dolphine's Nose. etc. Night stay in Ooty

After Breakfast check out & drive to coorg & relax from long drive & night stay hotel

About Coorg

Tropical forest is the most complex and least understood vegetation on earth and is also one of the most complicated of all ecosystems of the world. It consists of a rich array of species and a complex web or interactions. The tropical forests of Western

Ghats are in varying stages of development. The varying climatic, edaphic and physiographic conditions of different localities have lead to the development of the different forest types namely, Wet evergreen forests, Semi-evergreen forests, Moist deciduous forests, Sub-tropical hill forests and Grass lands.

The largest and serene river, Kauvery, originates on the eastern side of the Western Ghats. A major part of Coorg is watered by the tributaries of River Kauvery and by some other streams which are originated in or around Coorg.

Coorg is one of the major places in India where gets the highest rain fall every year. The intensity of the rainy season reaches its maximum in July and August. The average temperature of Coorg is 15°C and reaches at a maximum of 28°C in April and May. Climate of Coorg consists of three seasons. (1) Winter Season : December to February, (2) Summer Season : March to May and (3) Rainy Season : June to November.



Day 6

After breakfast visit coorg sightseeing like(Tala kaveri, Bagamandala, Abbey Falls, Omkareshwar temple, Raja seat, Nisarga Dama, TBTN colony, & night stay in the same hotel

Day 7

After breakfast check out & drop back to the Bangalore airport drop
